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To the Harris Chain of Lakes Restoration Council:

I spoke at the June 12<sup>th</sup> meeting of the St Johns River Water Management District Governing Board about the Management of the Dams and Lake Levels of the Harris Chain of Lakes.

They voted to keep the same minimum discharges used in the past of: 23 cfs

let out of the Apopka Beauclair Canal Dam

and 28 cfs let out of the Haynes Creek Dam

and 30 cfs let out of the Moss Bluff

Dam.

This vote was taken after I told them not to do this because it will lower Lake Griffin because more water is being let out of the Moss Bluff Dam than is coming in from the Haynes Creek Dam. These Minimum Discharges must be changed!

was just silence.

they <sup>(staff)</sup> said Lake Eustis was a Recharge  
Lake and Lake Griffin was a discharge lake  
and that was why they were going  
to ~~keep~~ keep the same Minimum Discharges.

I have noticed little improvement  
in the lake level on my Lake Griffin  
shoreline since 2010 when they shut  
down the Haynes Creek Dam.
