Subject: Status of Technical Memos regarding water quality in the Ocklawaha Chain of Lakes

This memo is to summarize the District's status on updates to technical memos addressing water quality in the Ocklawaha Chain of Lakes. Two technical memos on water quality were published in the past couple years.

- Technical Memorandum 56 - WATER QUALITY CHANGES IN LAKE APOPKA, FLORIDA, AND THE ST. JOHNS RIVER WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT'S RESTORATION PROGRAM by Michael F. Coveney was published in 2016. - Technical Memorandum 54-3 - NUTRIENT LOADING AND WATER QUALITY TRENDS IN THE UPPER OCKLAWAHA BASIN LAKES THROUGH 2016 by Rolland S. Fulton III was published in 2018.

We have no plans to update Memo 56. However, Dr. Rolly Fulton is planning on an update to memo 54-3, which would include data through calendar year 2018. We don't anticipate this document to be ready until early 2020.
