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## Agenda request for 5/3/2019 HCLRC meeting

### **Updates on Phosphorous(P) removal:**

1. Technical Advisor Group to identify package septic systems (apartments, group of trailers) around Harris Chain. TAG to identify municipal septic systems around Harris Chain (i.e. Winter Garden, Mt. Dora, Tavares, etc.) TAG to investigate use of the Advanced Bioretention System(ABS) to be used by Sustainable Water Investment Group(SWIG) on municipal septic systems around the Doctors Lake near Jacksonville. TAG to present SWIG plan using ABS to remove additional phosphorous from effluent downstream of septic plant. Mark Van Haden made a presentation to the District board meeting on 11/13/18 regarding this contract and it was approved by the Board. The Council knows there will be no quick solution to this effluent problem but a presentation will help identify how big the problem potentially is and how to solve the excess P problem .

2. Update on contract released to Phosphorous Free Solutions to remove P from Lake Apopka. This was approved by the District during the 11/13/18 Board meeting.
