Here is my list of invasive aquatic plants present in the HCOL based on my last surveys:

- *Alernanthera philoxeroides* – Alligator weed
- *Colocasia esculenta* – Wild Taro
- *Canna* spp (exotic) – canna all colors except yellow (native one)
- *Cyperus involacratus* – Umbrella flat sedge
- *Eichnornia crassipes* – Water Hyacinth
- *Hydrilla verticillata* – Hydrilla
- *Hygrophila polysperma* – Hygrophila
- *Hymenachne amplexicallis* – West Indian marsh
- *Lyngbya* spp. – Lyngbya
- *Nymphoides cristata* – crested floating heart
- *Oxycaryum cubense* – scirpus cubense
- *Panicum repens* – torpedograss
- *Pennisetum purpureum* – napier grass
- *Pistis stratiotes* – Water Lettuce
- *Salvinia minima* – water fern, water spangles
- *Sapuim sebiferum* – Chinese tallow
- *Sphagneticola tribolata* – Wedelia
- *Urochloa mutica* – Paragrass
